

V514 Personnel Qualifications Policy

Aim/Justification

This policy outlines the qualifications and competencies required for various positions / roles in the Amalgamated Pest Control Group.

Distribution

This policy is intended to be observed by all APC Personnel.

Personnel Qualifications Policy

1.0 Pest Management Technicians

1.1 General Pest Work

No person shall work unsupervised (without direct supervision – sight and sound) unless:

1. They possess Statements of Attainment for Units 5, 6 and 18 and
2. They have a pest management technicians licence (for the State/Territory that they will work in) and
3. In the case of a licensed technician that is either joining APC from another company or has been trained by an external Registered Training Organisation (RTO) - a Statement of Completion for the Amalgamised Course (APCT10 – 90104)

1.2 Timber Pest Work

No person shall do timber pest work unsupervised (without direct supervision – sight and sound) unless:

1. They possess Statements of Attainment for Units 6, 8 and 10 and
2. They have a pest management technician's licence endorsement (in the case where it is required by the licensing authority for the State/Territory that they will work in).
3. In the case of a licensed technician that is either joining APC from another company or has been trained by an external Registered Training Organisation (RTO) - a Statement of Completion for the Amalgamised Course (APCT10 – 90204)
